* Note: Each of the courses listed above are 3 credit courses. Elective courses will be offered from time to time to supplement this core curriculum. Elective courses will be counted toward graduation. Christian Service credits up to a total of six (1 credit per semester enrolled) will also apply.

WBBBI Graduation Requirements and Certificates Awarded

The WBBBI curriculum is laid out so that a person desiring general Bible knowledge can take the first year course and learn much of the basic information about the Bible, Jesus Christ, and Baptist history. The second year offers more in-depth doctrinal teaching, with an eye toward Christian service, marriage and child-rearing. Those who complete the third year will gain practical ministry preparation and training, with an emphasis on leadership, prophecy, and current Christian affairs.

Certificates Awarded

All completed courses will be given credit toward graduation. Some elective and additional courses will be offered to supplement the core curriculum. We offer a "WBBBI Certificate of Completion" for those who earn 20 credit hours. This is our one year program, and those credits all apply toward our two and three year diploma programs. The two year "WBBBI Sacred Studies" diploma requires 39 credit hours, and the three year "WBBBI Ministry Associate" diploma requires 57 credit hours. Students who fail to uphold a sound Christian testimony or who have an overall GPA below 2.0 ("C" average) will not be allowed to graduate.
