

Why Support Trained National Pastors?

American churches have long recognized the indispensable role of American missionaries on the foreign field. Their labors have resulted in many national pastors who are called of God to reach their own people with the gospel of Christ. This is the fulfillment of the plan of God set forth in the New Testament! Helping national pastors start churches has many practical advantages:

- They have a natural compassion for the souls of their own family and community.
- They already know their own culture and language.
- They do not need to raise funds for passage, shipping, and exorbitant rent.
- No “adjustment time” to set up a household is required.
- They are already citizens! They require no permits, visas or other government approval to remain in their country.
- If they can be helped with initial support, they do not have to take time to learn English, travel to the United States, raise money, take furloughs and report to American churches.
- They are not hirelings or “cheap labor!” They are men of God, called of God to preach, but they can plant a church and support their family for much less money than required by a foreign missionary, (typically about one-tenth the amount.)

Our Purpose

The **Omega Ministry** was established in January of 2000 as a way to provide temporary financial support for new fundamental Baptist pastors. While we do support some pastors in the United States, the main emphasis is upon **foreign national pastors and missionaries** who are planting churches on the foreign field.

Our Product

Since its inception, the **Omega Ministry** had grown tremendously. We have worked in about 60 countries, through more than 35 sending agencies, helping over 1,000 national pastors.



Our Program

Working exclusively through *local Baptist churches* and American *mission agencies*, we contact missionaries who are involved in training national pastors.

We ask them to submit names of worthy, God-called men they have trained who could use financial help.

They must have completed their pastoral training and agree to be accountable to that missionary for at least two years. The missionary agrees to provide oversight and to send quarterly reports to the **Omega Ministry** on the works he oversees.



Omega support is sent **through** the mission board to the account of the American missionary and **he distributes it to his men.** Support levels vary, but the **Omega Ministry** bases its support upon the missionary's recommendation and the availability of funds. Typically, a man is supported monthly at the \$100 level for two years. The support is only temporary (and only part of his total need) because we do not want to breed long-term dependency upon American money. Handling the funds in this way avoids many of the pitfalls encountered by other ministries.



Our Passion

The **Omega Ministry** is consecrated to the Lord Jesus Christ. Our goal is to be a conduit of blessing. We desire to bring glory to God, to see souls saved, and to be co-laborers with missionaries and donors until we hear the Lord's commendation in Matthew 25:21 **"Well done, good and faithful servant ... enter thou into the joy of thy Lord."**
